The Partnership

- Launched 2010 at the Petersberg Climate Dialogue by South Africa, Republic of Korea and Germany
- Semi-formal forum for **political dialogue and peer-exchange**
- More than 120 countries have participated in its various activities;
 open to all countries interested in ambitious climate action
- **Goal**: encourage all countries to step up for **enhanced transparency** in order to achieve the global goal of keeping temperature increase well below 2° Celsius, and pursuing efforts to limit it to 1.5°Celsius.
