## The measurement, reporting and verification framework under the L

National governments submit to the Conference of the Parties (COP) national reports on actions taken to implement the UNFCCC and to facilitate discussion on such implementation. The required contents and level of details of national reports and/or the timetable for their submission are different for developed and developing countries.

### Key players

Developing countries submit national reports including national communications and biennial update reports.

Developed countries provide, through the financial mechanism of the UNFCCC, financial and technical support to developing countries.

Consultative Group of Experts on National Communications from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention (CGE); provides technical advice and support to developing countries to prepare national communications and biennial update reports.

UNDP/UNEP Global Support Programme; provides technical support to developing countries to prepare national communications and biennial update reports.

Global Environment Facility (GEF); provides financial support to prepare national communications and biennial update reports.

The UNFCCC secretariat supports intergovernmental negotiations on the measurement, reporting and verification (MRV) framework under the UNFCCC and its implementation by developing countries.
