The basics


- Article 13 of the Paris Agreement establishes the Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF).
- Article 13 is operationalised with the modalities, procedures and guidelines (**MPGs**) and the Transparency Guidance

Purpose of the ETF "to build mutual trust and confidence and to promote effective implementation"





Partnership on Transparency in the Paris Agreement






Key elements of the Biennial Transparency Report (BTR)

Climate Helpdesk

Examples of Assistance

- Reviewing **GHG inventories** for specific sectors , e.g. waste sector
- Preparation of countries for the ETF and climate reporting requirements under the UNFCCC, e.g. Biennial Transparency Report (BTR)
- **Frameworks** for developing/updating NDCs and Long-term Strategies (LTS)
- Adaptation reporting

→ Providing rapid, high quality, short-term technical assistance on transparency, MRV systems, and NDCs tailored to country context



Eligibility criteria to submit a request

Topics related to transparency issues (in conjunction with NDCs or LTS)

Clear country ownership

Member of ODA country list


Endorsement by national UNFCCC Focal Point

Complementarity with other ongoing activities in-country (e.g. CBIT, UNDP, UNEP, ICAT)

Buy-in of key national stakeholders in the consultating process
